INTERACTIVE TREASURE MAP

Materials:

- markers & crayons
- scissors
- glue stick
- Treasure templates (pages 4-6)
- Optional: cardstock or construction paper

Directions:

1. Print and copy pages 4-6 for each student.
2. Have students choose 6 landforms to cut and paste onto their map. NOTE: They will only glue the gray shaded tabs to create flaps that lift up.
3. Cut and paste the treasure to “hide” it under the desired landform.
4. Cut and paste the “TRY AGAIN” labels under the other landforms.
5. On the “Hidden Treasure Clues” page, students will write down 3 clues about where they hid their treasure using cardinal directions (North, East, South, West) and landform features. Encourage students to start with more general clues and end with ones that are more specific.
6. Have students share their map with a partner, group or class! These make for such a fun bulletin board display!

3. Glue "TRY AGAIN" under the other landforms.



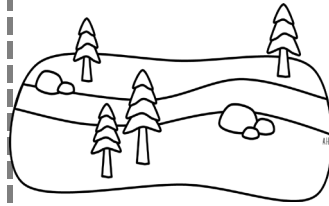
