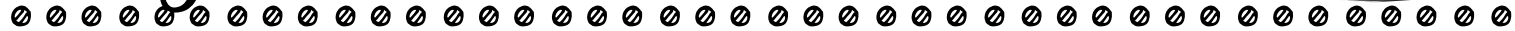

Materials:

- plastic sandwich bags
- Reindeer Food labels (page 3 or 4)
- scissors
- stapler
- measuring cup
- spoons
- oatmeal (rolled oats)
- dried cranberries
- festive holiday sprinkles

Directions:

1. Have each student measure out one cup of oatmeal.
2. Pour the oatmeal inside a sandwich bag.
3. Have students add a couple spoonfuls of cranberries to the inside the bag.
4. Add the "magic" sprinkles!
5. Finally, attach the double-sided label to each bag and have each child take one home for Christmas Eve!
