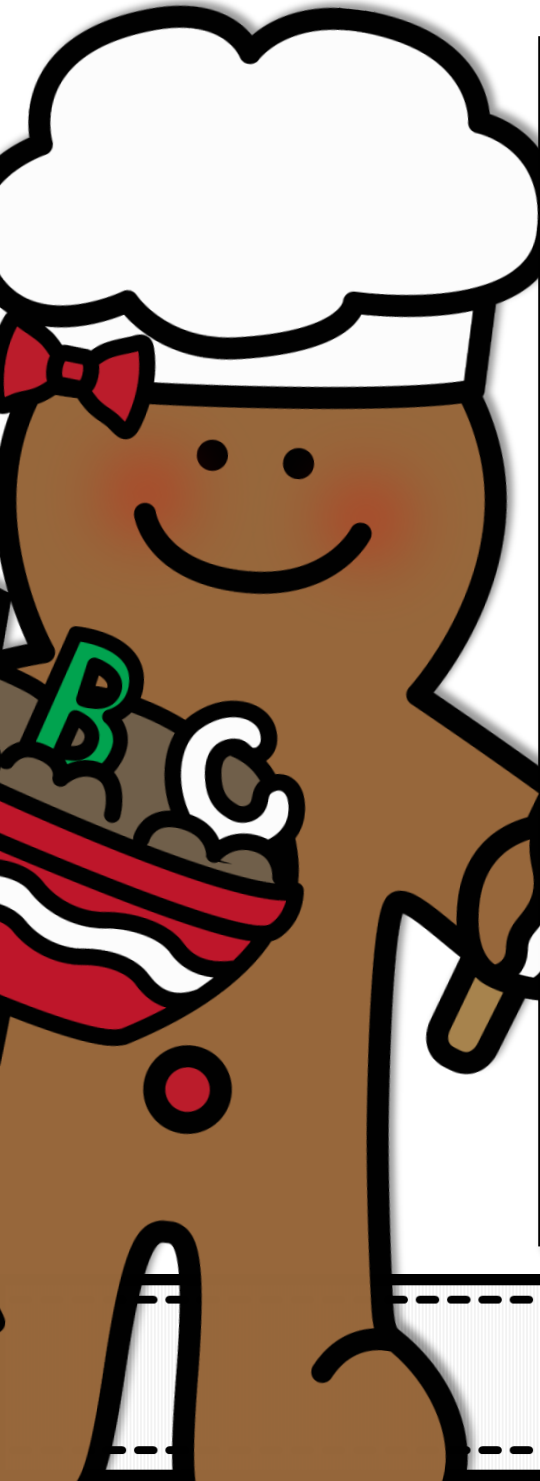

# Gingerbread play dough RECIPE

## Ingredients:

- 1 cup flour
- ½ cup of salt
- ½ Tbsp. ground ginger
- 1 Tbsp. ground cinnamon
- 1 Tbsp. vegetable oil
- ½ cup of water



Mix together  
and knead  
until smooth!





# Gingerbread play dough word center

## Materials:

- laminator
- alphabet stamps
- dry erase markers
- scissors
- gingerbread play dough
- editable word cards
- cookie sheet (*optional*)

## Directions:

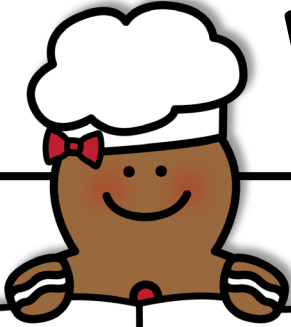
1. Make gingerbread play dough ahead of time or as a class using the recipe provided. Place the play dough in plastic zip bags or air-tight containers to use during center time.
2. Edit your desired word list on page 7. This allows you to customize sight words, spelling words, vocabulary words, etc.
3. Print and laminate the word cards. Cut them out.
4. Laminate the "Gingerbread Dough Word Mat". You can place the word mat on a cookie sheet to add to the "baking" fun!
5. Have students pick one word at a time to place on their cookie sheet. They will read this word first.
6. Next, have them write the word using a dry erase marker.
7. Lastly, have students roll out some dough. Using alphabet stamps or magnetic letters, press them into the dough to build the word.
8. Repeat this process with other word cards.



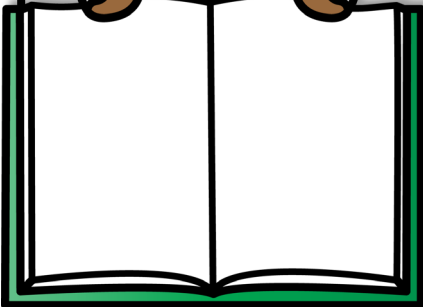

Pick a word card and read it.



Use a dry erase marker to write the word.

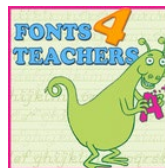

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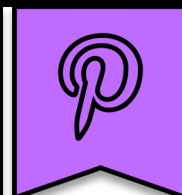
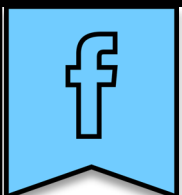
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
